

THIS INDENTURE, Witnesseth, That Fanny, a Black girl, late the slave of Jeremiah Beaton of Harford County, State of Maryland - for and in consideration of her manumission, by the said Jeremiah - which has been granted - made and which is hereunto annexed - and by and with the advice and consent of her Guardian and next friend Thomas Harrison,

as for other good causes she the said Fanny hath bound and put her self, and by these Presents doth bind and put her self Servant to the said Jeremiah Beaton to serve him his executors, administrators, and assigns, from the day of the date hereof, for and during the full term of Twenty one years and one Month - from thence next ensuing. During all which term the said Servant here said Master his - executors, administrators, and assigns faithfully shall serve, and that honestly and obediently in all things, as a good and dutiful Servant ought to do. AND the said Jeremiah his - executors, administrators, and assigns, during the said term, shall find and provide for the said Fanny sufficient meat, drink, Clothes, washing and lodging

AND for the true performance hereof, both the said parties bind themselves firmly unto each other by these Presents. IN WITNESS whereof, they have hereunto interchangeably set their hands and seals. Dated the fourteenth day of September annoque domini one thousand eight hundred and eleven
