

Glosham 5th mo. 22th 1834

Friend Daniel Gibbons I have taken up my pen by request of a coloured man that I have in my employ who calls himself Isaac Walker to make some enquiry relative to a brother of his which he says he left at thy house on his way here he wishes to know whether he still remains at thy house or in thy employ if he does not where he is if thee can tell and how he is in regard to health and ~~if~~ he says also that he has a sister ^{living in Collyersbridge} or had at the time he came through there he desires to hear from her if his brother has had any word from her since or could get word any way conveniently and he takes this opportunity of informing all that is desirous of knowing where he is that he is at the present time in the township of Glosham County of Montgomery one mile or thereabouts from the meeting house of friends and about the same distance from the Post office where he would be glad to find an answer to this letter as soon as practicable if this should come to hand and he further informs that the young man that came in company with him Joseph Smith by name is living at this time about one mile from where he does in the County of Bucks that they are at the present both in good health and rather expect to stay in this neighbourhood for one year if nothing should appear to obstruct
