<u>Biographical and Historical Note</u>: Dr. Herbert Huebener Beck was born 15 November 1870 in Lititz. He was a locally renowned educator, author, and sportsman. He was head of the Chemistry Department at Franklin and Marshall College and a member of Lititz Moravian Church. He died 22 December 1960.
