

HOUSE RULES

1. Fin and Feather Beneficial Association will not be responsible for any debts or bills of any kind or nature unless same is in writing upon the properly executed requisition order blank of the association and authorized by the proper authority.

2. The Social Quarters shall be open from 7 A. M. every day in the year, including Sundays and holidays, excepting during sessions of the association, when the Social Quarters shall be closed, unless otherwise provided for.

3. No gambling shall be permitted in any quarters of the association.

4. No persons who are not members of the club in good standing shall be admitted to the Social Quarters, or permitted to purchase intoxicating liquors. Each member introducing a guest or visitor shall, with the guest, be liable for any injury and all damage done in and about the association rooms by such guest or members. The association will not be responsible and, upon retiring, must take his guest or visitor with him.

5. Profane language, boisterous or ungentlemanly conduct or intoxication is strictly prohibited and any member guilty of the same may fined or excluded from the association until such time as the Executive Committee may take further action.

6. No refreshments shall be served to anyone in an intoxicated condition.

7. No subscriptions, tickets or merchandise selling shall be circulated or exposed or advertisements displayed in the association without the consent of the Executive Committee.

8. Any destruction or injury to property of the association or otherwise shall be paid for by the person committing such injury, and the amount shall be determined by the Executive Committee.

9. No member who is in arrears for fines, dues or other indebtedness to the association shall be permitted to the association or the Social Quarters.

10. The Executive Committee shall decide the compensation of their officers and employees.

11. The Steward shall be employed and maintain his position as long as he is working for the best interest of the association and at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

12. Any member or officer of the association may be fined, removed, suspended or expelled from his office or from the association or from both for any of the following causes:

1—Dishonesty, immoral conduct, intoxication, quarreling, or tending to reflect discredit upon the order.

2—Violation of all or any part of the membership obligation.

The Executive Committee has full authority and is required strictly to enforce the foregoing rules.

These Executive Committee rules were approved by the association on Sept. 3, 1946, and these by-laws and Executive Committee rules were approved by the association on the third reading after due notice was mailed to all members of the association.
