Opinion of the Court, on the
Administration account on the
exceptions; of George Hank dec.

On Exceptions to the Administration Account on the Estate of George
Percival.

It is admitted that the 1st. 2^d. 3^d. & 11th. Exceptions are well founded
and that the Items for Legacies and portions paid should be set against
the Balance, and the Account must be corrected accordingly.

The 8th. Exception relates to the debt due by Sailor, and the Court are
of opinion, under all the circumstances of the case, that the Accomplish
ought to be allowed the amount of it.

We think that 100 £. should be deducted from the commission charged
With these corrections the Account will be allowed.
