YOU are hereby commanded, that the Body of *Jonathan Warlan* under your custody detained, as it is said, together with the day and cause of *his* being taken and detained, by whatsoever name the said *Jonathan Warlan* shall be charged in the same, you have, under safe and secure conduct, before the honorable *the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas now holding a Court for said County, forthwith* in the ^{City} borough of Lancaster, at ~~at~~ *o'clock*, in the ~~noon~~; to do and receive all those things which the said Judge shall then and there consider of in this particular.

WITNESS the honorable *Walter Franklin*, Esquire, President of the Court of Common Pleas of said County, at Lancaster, the *fifteenth* day of *March* in the year of our LORD, one thousand eight hundred and *twenty one*
