next & the same goods Plates & Glass of the said at the time of
his death or which at any time after shall come to the hands or possession

person or persons for less to worth only and in effect according to Law
by Land or water or land to be made a true & present account of the said
goods upon or before the third day of may which will be in the
year of our Lord 1733 all the rest & residue of the said Goods Plates
the said which shall be paid to the said Lancaster in upon the 25th day of the month of
the same being first examined & checked off by the amanuensis of
the County of Lancaster shall take in & pay unto such person or persons
as the aforesaid Court by these Vores or instance shall
Lancaster appointed & it shall have been agreed that any Captain
or Captaincy was added to the said Lancaster their name & place
the same in to the Register & Conservall Office making Request to have
it allowed accordingly if the said Margret Murray being there unto Request
to Captaincy the said Captaincy of admittance of registration of the Captain
being first had & heard in the Register Office the aforesaid obligation
to be done & of one & each of the rest given and put force under
Sealed & Delivred
