Possession or Knowledge of the said James Allison or into the hands or Possession  
of any other person or persons for him And the same to be made Do Exhibit or Cause  
to be Exhibited

to the Register in his Office in Lancaster County on or before the tenth  
teenth day of October next And the same Goods Chattels & Credits of the said Deceased  
at the time of his Death or within at any time after that come to the hands or  
Possession of the said James Allison or into the hands or Possession of any other  
person or persons for him Do well & truly Administer according to Law And  
further Do make or Cause to be made a true & Just Acc't. of his Administration  
at or before the seven tenth day of September which will be in the year of our  
Lord 1743 And all the rest & residue of the said Goods Chattels & Credits which  
shall be found Remaining on the said Administrators Acc't. (the same being  
first Examined & allowed by the Orphans Court of the said County) shall
