Know all men by these presents that we Moses She Drayton on the
part of William Buckley Esq of the County of Lancaster & Province
of Pennsylvania have granted and sold & firm by bond unto William Dunbar
Regis the General in the sum of forty £ of pounds lawfull money
of Pennsylvania to be paid unto the said William Dunbar Register
or to his and our Attorney Executors Administrors or Assignes to the whole
pay ment well & truly to be made to the said our shay Justice & weally our
Executors & Adminors each & every of them finally by their payers
shaid with my seal & date this 23rd day of March 1747

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above shaid
Moses She Drayton Administrator of all & singular the Goods & Chattels
of all & singular the Goods Chattels & Goods of the said Deed which came to
the hands of the Assignors of this Money She Drayton or any of the hands of any other
person or persons for him & the same is made do & should or cause to be shaid
unto the Regis the General or before the 25th day of April next & by any one
of the shaid & shaid do will & truly Administrator Executors & Assignors to do & pay the
same or cause to be made at the request of the said Deed

And if before the 25th day of March next & all the 25th residue of the said
Goods Chattels & Goods do & shaid shall be found & remaining upon the said
Administrator Deed the same being first examined & allowed of by the
Ordinary & Court of this County shall be lawfull & pay to such person or persons
as they Ordinary & Court shall direct & if it shall hereafter happen that any land
Wills the land was made by this said Deed or by the Executors or Assignors
therein named do & shaid the same unto the Register's Office making report
to have it allowed & approved according to the said Money then being
then unto the said Deed or do & shaid up on the letters of Amos She Drayton
