bate of Wills and granting Letters of Administration in the Province of Penn-
sylvania in the Sum of *Two hundred pounds*
Pounds lawfull Money of the said Province to be pay'd unto the said WILLIAM

To the which payment well and truly to be made We do bind ourselves jointly

firmly by these Presents. Sealed with our Seals and Dated this *Seventy eighth*
Day of *Aprill* in the Year of our Lord one Thousand seven Hundred
and *fourty nine*.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, that if the above bounden *John*

Administrators of all and singular the Goods and Chattles, Rights and Credits which were

and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods and Chattles, Rights and Credits,
