Magistrate General for the Province of New York and County Town of Albany taken on and for the presence of the said PHEMME in the sum of one hundred pounds lawful money of the said Province to be paid to the said Peter Aulth et al to his certain attorney Peter Lee Esq. or his agents to the whole payment well and truly to be made or to be by him or his said attorney and agents with our said Seal the second Day of November next 1751

The Condition of this obligation is that that if the above bounden Peter Aulth administrator of all and singular the goods

rights and Credits which were of Michael Meyer Deceased do make or cause to be made above and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods rights and Credits which were of the said Deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Peter Aulth or into the hands possession or knowledge of any other person or persons for him and the same do make do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the High Court of the County of Albany the 20th day of December next and for him to make or cause to be made above and just account exhibition or reckoning of the said administration all or before the third Day of November next 1752

and all the rest and residue of the said goods rights and Credits which shall be found remaining upon the said administrator account the same being first examined and allowed of by the Corporate Court of the County of Albany which shall have and pay to that person or persons respectively as the said Court by its Justice or Justices shall think and appoint and finally after approval that any Act

Warrant or warrant or process by the said Deceased and the Esq. or his heirs should do exhibit the same unto the said office making request to have it allowed and approved of accordingly if the said Peter Aulth being hereunto required do think and cause up the said letters of administration application of the said Deceased being first had and made in the said office then the above Obligation to be void or else to be void remain in full force and virtue as if the said Peter Aulth were dead
