all of the County of Lancaster, and Province of Pennsylvania, are held and firmly bound unto *Benjamin Chew* Esq; Register-General for the Probate of Wills, and granting Letters of Administration in the Province of Pennsylvania, in the Sum of *2500* *Pounds* lawful Money of the said Province, to be paid unto the said *Benjamin Chew* or to his certain Attorney, Executors, Administrators, or Assigns. To the which Payment well and truly to be made, We do bind ourselves jointly and severally, our Heirs, Executors, and Administrators, each and every of them, firmly by these Presents Sealed with our Seals, and dated this *Twenty fourth* Day of *May* in the Year of our LORD, One Thousand Seven Hundred and *Seventy*

**T**HE Condition of the above Obligation is such, That

if the above-bounded *Peter Free Stabor and Elizabeth* Administrators of all and singular the Goods and Chattles, and Credits, of *George Burr* deceased *do* make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods and Chattles, and Credits, of the said deceased, which have, or shall come to the Hands, Possession or Knowledge of the said *Peter Free Stabor and Elizabeth his wife* or into the Hands or Possession of any other Person or Persons for *him* and the same so made, do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited, into the Register's Office in the County of Lancaster, at or before the *Twenty seventh* Day of *June* next ensuing, and the same Goods, Chattles, and Credits, and all other Goods, Chattles, and Credits, of the said deceased, at *the* Time of his Death, which at any Time *after*, shall come to the Hands or Possession of the said *Peter Free Stabor and Elizabeth his wife* or into the Hands or Possession of any other Person or Persons for *him* well and truly administer, according to Law: And further, *do* make, or cause to be made, a true and just Account of said Administration, at or before the *Twenty seventh* Day of *May* next, which will be in the Year of our Lord, One Thousand Seven Hundred and *Seventy* and all the Rest and Residue of the said Goods, Chattles and Credits, which shall be found remaining upon the said Administrators Account (the same being first examined and allowed of by the Orphan's Court of the County aforesaid) deliver and pay unto such Person or Persons respectively, as the said Orphan's Court by their Decree or Sentence (pursuant to the true Intent and meaning of an Act, intituled, "An Act for the better setting Intestates Estates") shall limit and appoint.
