OF August — SESSIONS MDCCCXXXIX. —

The Grand Inquest of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, inquiring in and for the body of the county of Lancaster, on their oaths and affirmations respectively, do present: That *Lewis Culbertson* — late of the said county, *Ex. Keeper* — on the *first* day of *August* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *thirty nine* and at divers other days and times, as well before as afterwards, at the said county and within the jurisdiction of this said Court, with force and arms did keep a tippling house, without any license so to do first had and obtained according to law, and then and there without such license, did sell and deliver, and cause to be sold and delivered to sundry persons divers quantities of rum wine brandy. *Whiskey - Gin* and other spirits by less measure than one quart each contrary to the form of the Act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
