The Grand Inquest of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, inquiring in and for the body of the county of Lancaster, on their oaths and affirmations respectively, do present: That Lewis Culbertson late of the said county, has Kuper on the first day of the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine and at divers other days and times, as well before as afterwards, at the said county and within the jurisdiction of this said Court, with force and arms did keep a tippling house, without any license so to do first had and obtained according to law, and then and there without such license, did sell and deliver, and cause to be sold and delivered to sundry persons divers quantities of rum wine brandy.
