THE GRAND INQUEST of the Commonwealth of
Pennsylvania, inquiring in and for the body of the County of
Lancaster, upon their oaths and affirmations, respectively DO
PRESENT, THAT *Robert Ketchum*

late of the said County, *yeoman* on the *twenty seventh*
day of *October* — in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and *fifty seven*
at the County aforesaid, and within the jurisdiction of this Court,
did commit fornication with a certain *Cecilia Troyer*

and then and there did beget a
female bastard child on the body of her the said
Cecilia Troyer — contrary to the
form of the act of General Assembly, in such cases made and
provided, and against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth
of Pennsylvania.
