May Sessions 1794

THE GRAND INQUEST for this Commonwealth, and for the Body of the County of Lancaster upon their Oath, *Affirmation* do present, that *Ludwig Mey* the *first* Day of *May* in the Year of our Lord, One thousand seven hundred and *Ninety four* at the County aforesaid, and within the Jurisdiction of this Court, did keep a Tipling-House without any Licence so to do, being first had and obtained according to Law, and then and there, without such Licence, did sell and deliver, and cause to be sold and delivered, to sundry persons, divers Quantities of *Rum wine* and other spirituous Liquors by less Measures than *one quart* each against the Form of the Act of Assembly in such Case made and provided, and against the Peace and Dignity of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
