Lancaster County aforesaid
upon their Oath and Affirmation Respectively do present that Wendal
Runniger of Lancaster in Lancaster County Yeoman

the tenth day of October in the first year of the Reign of our
Sovereign Lord George the ~~second~~^{third} King of Great Britain France & Ireland
Defender of the Faith &c And divers other days and times as well before
as after at Lancaster in the County of Lancaster
and within the Jurisdiction of this Court did keep a Tippling House &
without being first Recommended by the Justices of the County
Court of general Quarter Sessions of the Peace for the County
of Lancaster in their said Court to the Lieutenant Governor
of the Province of Pennsylvania for his

Licence for so doing or without Obtaining such Licence & then and there
without such Recommendation or Licence did sell and Deliver & cause
to be sold and Delivered to sundry persons divers Quantities of Wine
Rum and other strong Liquors by less Measure than
one Quart each

against the form of the Acts of General Assembly of this province
in such case made and provided And against the peace of our said
Lord the King his Crown & Dignity &c
