is for Lancaster County aforesaid
upon their Oath and Affirmation respectively do present that
Susannah Swarts of Lancaster in the County of Lancaster
Spinster

the tenth — day of October — in the first — year of the
Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the ~~second~~^{third} by the Grace of God
King of Great-Britain France and Ireland Defender of the Faith &c
and at divers other Days & Times as well before as after at Lancaster
in the County of Lancaster

and within the Jurisdiction of this Court did keep a tippling House
without being first recommended by the Justices of the County
Court of ^{generally} Quarter Sessions of the Peace for the County of Lancaster
to the Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Pennsylvania

for his
License for so doing ^{and} without obtaining such License & then &
there without such Recommendation or License did sell & deliver
& cause to be sold, ^{delivered} to sundry Persons divers Quantities of Rum &
other strong Spirits by less Measures than one Quart each

said Lord the King his Crown & Dignity &c
