The Grand Inquest of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, inquiring for the County of Lancaster upon their respective oaths and affirmations, do present, That

Joseph Leibfried

late of the said County, on the 8th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety five at the County aforesaid, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with force and arms, in and upon one Jacob Bachman in the peace of the said Commonwealth then and there being, did make an assault and hit the said Jacob Bachman did beat, wound and ill treat, and other wrongs, to him the said Jacob Bachman then and there did, to the great damage of the said Jacob Bachman contrary to the form of the Act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

And the Inquest aforesaid, upon their respective oaths and affirmations aforesaid, do further present, that the said

afterwards, to wit: on the same day and year aforesaid, at the County aforesaid, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with force and arms, &c.,

on the said in the peace of God and of the said Commonwealth then and there being, did make another assault, and then and there unlawfully and maliciously did inflict grievous bodily harm upon the said

contrary to the form of the Act of General Assembly in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

And the Inquest aforesaid, upon their respective oaths and affirmations aforesaid, do further present, That the said

afterwards, to wit: on the same day and year, at the County aforesaid, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with force and arms, &c.,

on the said in the peace of God and of the said Commonwealth then and there being, feloniously did make another assault and the said

then and there feloniously, wilfully and of malice aforethought, did

with an intent the said

then and there feloniously, wilfully and of malice aforethought to kill and murder,

contrary to the form of the Act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
