for eighty Dollars payable on or before the first day of
June 1817 by said John Brutt and Frederick Yarger to
said Jacob Hoffmann, this day after taken from the
hand of said Jacob Hoffmann, did tear into small pieces
and put the same into his pocket, and after he had torn
the same, denied that had it until the pieces was found
by him, on examination, neglect of Bail. And you the
said keeper are hereby required to receive the said John
Brutt into your custody in the said Common Gaol, and
keep him safely to keep until discharged by due course
of Law, Witness the said George S. Snyder at Elizabeth
town the sixteenth day of February A. D. one thousand
eight hundred and nineteen,
