Upon condition that he the said William Bleyer shall personally appear at the next Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace to be helden at Lancaster in and for the County of Lancaster then and there to answer such matters and things as may be objected against him for threatening (See above) and not depart the said Court without licence, and in the mean time to keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards all the Citizens of this Commonwealth & especially towards her the said Maria Smith then the above recognizance to be void, otherwise that said several sums of Money be levied of their goods & chattels Lands & Tenements respectively to the use of the Commonwealth +
