Shall be objected to him on behalf of the Commonwealth
for Fornication on a certain Sophia Meyer and not depart
the said Court without Licence then the above Recognizance
to be void otherwise the said several sums of Money
To be levied of the said Groff and Chattels Lands and Tenement
respecting to the use of the Commonwealth — — —
