The Condition of this Recognizance  
is such that if the above bounden George Casey shall personally  
appear at the next Court of quarter Session of the Peace to  
be held in and for the said County of Lancaster on the  
Last Monday of November next and there & there to  
Answer a Bill of Inditement for retailing & selling  
Liquors by less measure than one quart, at one time  
and to one person, without having obtained a License  
agreeable to Law for that Purpose, and in the mean  
time behave him self Peaceable to all (peaceable) People of  
the united States and that he doth not depart without  
leave of Court, then this Recognizance to be void and  
else to remain in full force & virtue —
