

# Hanover Township Tax Lists: 1750-1783

## Vol. 14 of 20

Note: This file contains images from a microfilm that was created several decades ago. When the microfilm was created, it did not include breaks demarcating the different years of tax assessments. Some pages of the tax assessments include the year; some pages do not.

It appears that the creators of this microfilm reel meant for the images to be in chronological order. However, there are some images that appear to be out of order. Therefore, patrons are warned that determining the specific years of the separate images is problematic. Patrons are urged to study the images in order to discern which pages belong together. Once the grouping of the images is established, patrons should then look for any markings that show the year. If an inscription with the year is found, patrons should then compare the inscription to other handwriting on that page. Does the handwriting match? Does the year look like it was written with the same ink used on the rest of the page? If not, it is possible that the inscription of the year was not contemporaneous with the creation of the tax assessment and should not be considered authoritative.

The images in these files follow the same order of the original microfilm. All images, even blank pages, have been retained in order to facilitate reconstruction of the source microfilm.

Although the pages have been grouped into separate files, patrons are warned that the groupings are arbitrary. Because the images usually include two pages, patrons should consider the possibility that the page on the left hand side is the last page of the preceding group of pages and that the right hand page is the first page of the next group of pages.

Patrons are also warned that some pages appear twice. The duplications appear on the microfilm and are reproduced here. The main reason for apparent duplications is that the bound leaves of the assessment are not all the same size. There are a few pages that are much smaller than their neighbors. The smaller pages cover up some text on the following page. Therefore, a second image had to be created with the smaller page turned, thus allowing for text underneath to be uncovered. However, patrons are warned that other pages, without such impediments, are duplicated, and the rationale for the duplication is not apparent.

the several Sums in your Duplicate respectively mentioned, and you shall com-  
and pay in the whole and every the Sums aforesaid, unto William Henry Esq<sup>r</sup>  
on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> Day of December next.  
If any shall neglect or refuse Payment, on the first Demand made after the Ap-  
you are then to levy the same on the Goods and Chattels of the Person so re-  
; for which Purpose we do hereby empower you to call to your Assistance, (if  
ation be) any Constable, or other Person, and in Case of Resistance, to break  
in the Day-Time, any House, Trunk, Box, Chest, Closet, Cupboard, or  
Things, where any such Offenders Goods, Chattels or Effects are supposed to  
and make Distress and Sale thereof, rendering the Overplus, if any be, to the  
er, reasonable Charges, allowed by the Commissioners, being first deducted; but  
Owner refuse to receive such Overplus, when tendered to him before one  
then pay the same to the Treasurer of this County; but if no Distress can  
and the Person refuse to shew you Goods or Chattels of his or her own  
to satisfy the Money then due, with Charges, take the Body of the Per-  
refusing to the County Jail, and deliver him or her to the Sheriff, or Keeper of  
Jail, who shall detain him or her in safe Custody, without Bail or Mainprize,  
payment be made, and the Constable and all other Persons within your District  
commanded to be assisting to you, if there be Occasion. Fail not at  
well.

Further you are to take Notice, that all Persons who have taken the Oath, or  
of Allegiance to this State, have a Right to pay the one half Part of the  
and the Hard Money Tax, in State Money, emitted in Pursuance of an Act  
the 7th Day of April, 1781, for which Purpose the Persons who have taken  
are placed separately. But the Tax called the State Money Tax, may be  
in any Sort of State Money. The Fines in your Duplicate are paid in the  
Money as the Taxes to which they belong.
