*Tenth* Day of *January next*  
at the Court house in *Lanc<sup>r</sup> Borough*

But if you can not meet with the Person, of whom Demand is to be made, leave Notice in Writing with some of the Family, or at the Place of their last Abode, signifying the Day of Appeal; at which Time you are to attend with this duplicate & the Names of such Persons in your district, as you find omitted herein, Fail not at your Peril.

INTRODUCTORY NOTE

The microfilm of which this roll constitutes a part reproduces original tax records now in the custody of the Lancaster County Historical Society. Totalling sixty-eight boxes and seven volumes, these records were created during the assessment and collection of taxes in the political subdivisions of that county. They were transferred to the historical society by the Lancaster County Commissioners in 1961.

The bulk of these records, amounting to sixty-seven boxes and dating from the period 1748-1855, are of the following subdivisions (townships unless otherwise identified) which remain today in Lancaster County:

The remaining records, comprising one box and seven volumes, are of townships which were formerly in Lancaster County but are today in Dauphin and/or Lebanon counties (erected in 1785 and 1813, respectively). These particular records date from a shorter period: that of 1750-1788. The townships to which they pertain, and the counties in which these townships are now located, are as follows:
