on or before the Day of next.

AND if any person or persons shall neglect or refuse to make payment within forty days after demand made by you, it shall and may be lawful to and for you: And you are hereby commanded and required, to apply to the next Justice of the Peace within the county, where such delinquents reside, and to deliver to such Justice a list in writing signed by you, containing the names of all such delinquents, together with the sums of money due from them respectively, according to the said assessments. Fail not at your peril.

THESE are to require you, to collect and receive from the Persons assessed the County Tax in your Duplicate respectively mentioned, in gold or silver Money.

And you shall compleat and pay, in the whole and every the Sums aforesaid, unto

Treasurer, on or before the *first* - Day of *Aprill*
five next, but if any shall neglect or refuse payment, by the space of *five* Days after demand made, you are then to levy the same, on the Goods and Chattels of the Persons refusing; for which purpose we do hereby empower you to call to your Assistance, if occasion be, any Constable or other Person, and in case of Resistance, to break open in the day time, any House, Trunk, Box, Chest, Closet, Cupboard, or other Things, where any such Offenders Goods, Chattels, and Effects are supposed to be, and make distress and sale thereof, rendering the Overplus (if any be) to the Owner, reasonable charges being first deducted; but if no distress can be found, and the Person refuses to shew you Goods or Chattels of his or her own forthwith, to satisfy the Money then due, with charges, take the body of the Person so refusing to the County Goal, and deliver him or her, to the Sheriff or Keeper of said Goal, who shall detain him or her, in safe custody, without Bail or Mainprize until payment be made, and the Constable and all other Persons within your district, are hereby commanded to be assisting to you, if there be occasion. Fail not at your Peril.

INTRODUCTORY NOTE

The microfilm of which this roll constitutes a part reproduces original tax records now in the custody of the Lancaster County Historical Society. Totalling sixty-eight boxes and seven volumes, these records were created during the assessment and collection of taxes in the political subdivisions of that county. They were transferred to the historical society by the Lancaster County Commissioners in 1961.

The bulk of these records, amounting to sixty-seven boxes and dating from the period 1748-1855, are of the following subdivisions (townships unless otherwise identified) which remain today in Lancaster County:

The remaining records, comprising one box and seven volumes, are of townships which were formerly in Lancaster County but are today in Dauphin and/or Lebanon counties (erected in 1785 and 1813, respectively). These particular records date from a shorter period: that of 1750-1788. The townships to which they pertain, and the counties in which these townships are now located, are as follows:
