This resource is a digital facsimile of a microfilm reel. The microfilm reel is part of a collection entitled "Federal population census schedules in the custody of the Pennsylvania State Library, 1850-80".

This Social Statistics file presents data for each township and borough in the county. The types of data include the following: Valuation of estate, real, and personal; Annual taxes; Seasons and crops with "usual average crop"; Schools/colleges/academies and the number of students; libraries and the number of volumes; Newspapers/periodicals and their circulation; Religious organizations/churches along with the number of persons they can accommodate and the valuation of church property; number of paupers; number of criminals; and average wages for six different categories of work.

Each township and borough should be represented in these pages but omissions are present. For instance, there are two entries for "Manheim Borough" yet there is no entry for "Manheim Township". Also, the microfilm originally had the townships/boroughs listed in quasi-alphabetical order. Instead of retaining that format, this resource has been reordered so that all entries are in alphabetical order.
