in the Borough of Lancaster: But if you cannot meet with Persons, of whom demand is to be made, leave notice in Writing with some of the Family, or at the Place of their last Abode, signifying the Day of Appeal, at which Time you are to attend with this Duplicate, and the Names of such Persons in your District, as you find omitted herein. Fail not at your Peril. Dated the Thirtieth Day of May A. D. 1780.
