

Upper Paxton Township Tax Lists: 1769-1783

Vol. 3 of 13

Note: This file contains images from a microfilm that was created several decades ago. When the microfilm was created, it did not include breaks demarcating the different years of tax assessments. Some pages of the tax assessments include the year; some pages do not.

It appears that the creators of this microfilm reel meant for the images to be in chronological order. However, there are some images that appear to be out of order. Therefore, patrons are warned that determining the specific years of the separate images is problematic.

Patrons are urged to study the images in order to discern which pages belong together. Once the grouping of the images is established, patrons should then look for any markings that show the year. If an inscription with the year is found, patrons should then compare the inscription to other handwriting on that page. Does the handwriting match? Does the year look like it was written with the same ink used on the rest of the page? If not, it is possible that the inscription of the year was not contemporaneous with the creation of the tax assessment. If so, the inscription of the year should not be considered authoritative.

The images in these files follow the same order of the original microfilm. All images, even blank pages, have been retained in order to facilitate reconstruction of the source microfilm.

Although the pages have been grouped into separate files, patrons are warned that the groupings are arbitrary. Because the images usually include two pages, patrons should consider the possibility that the page on the left hand side is the last page of the preceding group of pages and that the right hand page is the first page of the next group of pages.

Patrons are also warned that some pages appear twice. The duplications appear on the microfilm and are reproduced here. The main reason for apparent duplications is that the bound leaves of the assessment are not all the same size. There are a few pages that are much smaller than their neighbors. The smaller pages cover up some text on the following page. Therefore, a second image had to be created with the smaller page turned, thus allowing for text underneath to be uncovered. However, patrons are warned that other pages, without such impediments, are duplicated, and the rationale for the duplication is not apparent.

YOU being appointed Collector of the within Taxes, are hereby required to demand of the Persons within mentioned, the several Sums, wherewith they stand charged: But if any think themselves agrieved with what they are hereby rated, acquaint them that the Day of Appeal is the

Second Day of
October next at the Court House,

in the Borough of Lancaster: But if you cannot meet with Persons, of whom Demand is to be made, leave Notice in Writing with some of the Family, or at the Place of their last Abode, signifying the Day of Appeal, at which Time you are to attend with this Duplicate, and the Names of such Non-Associators, in your District, as you find omitted herein. Fail not at your Peril. Dated the

21 Day of *August* A. D. 1777.
