- d. Edward H. Rausch, Columnist, Author of *Pennsylvania Dutch Handbook*, c 1873
- e. Mrs. John F. Steinman, Author of popular light novels of 1920's, *Prophet and the King*, c 1956
- f. Rev. Alexander Mack, Jr., 1712–1803 "Brother Timotheus" of Ephrata Cloisters, Bishop Brethern Church, Author of hymns, poetry
- g. Mrs. Sally Hastings, 1773–1812, Maytown poetess, Author of *Poems in Different Subjects*, 1808
- h. Rev. Thomas Barton, 1759–1778, Rector St. James Episcopal, Contributor to *Pennsylvania Gazette*
- i. Rev. G. Henry Ernest Muhlenberg, 1753–1815, Pastor Trinity Lutheran Church, renowned botanist, Author of *Catalog of Plants* 1813, *English German Dictionary*, 1812
- j. Clyde Miller, 1887–1964, Carpenter, homespun poet, Contributor to Marietta newsweekly
- k. Miss Blanche Nevin, 1838–1925, sculptor, poetess, Author of *Great Grandmother's Looking Glass* and other poems

- l. Aaron H. Danner, 1836—, Manheim merchant, civic leader, Verse writer for *Manheim Sentinel*
- m. Gerald S. Lestz, Former journalist *Lancaster New Era*, publisher, enthusiast of local history and building preservation, Author of *Historic Heart of Lancaster*, 1963
- n. James Scott Brown, 1826—1890, school teacher, Author of *Bouquet and other Poems* 1858
- o. Robert Blair Rish, 1848—, Journalist, *Lancaster Daily Examiner*, Author of *Observed and Noted*, 1893
- p. John W. Price, Sc. D. Curator Emeritus North Museum, former columnist *Intelligencer Journal*
- q. Johann Conrad Beissel, 1681—1768, Founder and Superintendent Ephrata Cloisters, songwriter, Author of innumerable papers, tracts, religious books and of the first book of poetry written and published in America
- r. Mabel Koch, Editor of *Manheim Sentinel* Columnist
- s. Rev. Calvin Seibert Gerhard, D.D. Pastor Trinity Reformed Church Columbia, Columnist for *Lancaster Daily Examiner* Author of Reformed Church Literature including *Death and the Resurrection*, c 1895
- t. Carl W. Dreppard, 1892—1956, Advertising business, Curator Landis Valley Museum Editor of *Spinning Wheel*, Author of books on antiques and a *National Primer in the Modern Manner*.
- u. James Buchanan, 1791—1868, Fifteenth President of the United States, writer of song tunes, poetry, Author of *Mr. Buchanan's Administration on the Eve of Rebellion*, c 1866

- v. **Ling Fang Tsai**, Retired Presbyterian Missionary, Author of, *Queen of the Dark Chamber*, c 1953
- w. **Rev. Henry Martin John Klein, D.D.**, Pastor Grace Reformed, York, Pa. Emeritus Prof. History and Archaeology, F. & M. College, Civic leader. Author of books on church and local history including *Lancaster County Pennsylvania; a History*, c 1925 (4 vols.)
